### Project "Powered" promotes construction of wind power plants

TIRANA, January. (ATA). The Steering Committee of energy project POWERED met at the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Energy in Tirana on Monday to take stock on the project's state and discuss strategies on development of alternative energy sources, particularly wind power.


The European Project Powered (Project of Offshore Wind Energy: Research, Experimentation, Development) includes Italy's Adriatic regions of Abruzzo, Puglia, Veneto, Marche, as well as countries like Albania and Montenegro.

The goal of this project is to collect scientific data and assess the technical and economic conditions to encourage investment in wind power plants offshore in the Adriatic Sea. The 4 million euro project is co-financed by the IPA CBC Adriatic.

Ministry of Economy, Trade and Energy is a major partner in this activity with main focus on strategies on development of alternative energy sources, particularly wind power in Albania.

The project was praised by Professor Renato Ricci and Antonio Sorgi, manager of the Energy for the Region Abruzzo, who is also the project manager.
